

WINTER REGULATIONS FOR THE COMMUNITY OF ISCHGL

The community of Ischgl has decided to implement the following regulations over winter to improve our time together and increase safety. These rules will be constantly monitored and in the event of non-compliance, a fine may be incurred. Please therefore ensure that you follow these regulations.



PEDESTRIAN ZONES

To increase safety for the many pedestrians, various signposted areas* in Ischgl have been designated as pedestrian zones. Vehicles may not be driven here.



- Shortest route for guests to arrive and leave
- Loading (fresh produce from 6:00 to 9:00, other deliveries from 7:00 to 9:00 and from 11:00 to 14:30)
- Journeys by residents or employees working in the pedestrian zone with an access pass
- Carts and bikes



ALCOHOLIC DRINKS

In public places**, it is not permitted to serve or consume alcohol or to carry alcohol in open containers (e.g. bottle, glass, can)

Exception: officially permitted events and second-hand markets.



TAXIS

Taxis may only drive into the pedestrian zone if they have been ordered via the TVB and community app

Guests with luggage are permitted to arrive at or depart from the pedestrian zone at any time (incl. by taxi)



WALKING IN SKI BOOTS AND WEARING SKIS

It is not permitted to walk in ski boots or wear/carry skis, ski poles and snow-boards between 20:00 and 6:00.

Exceptions:

- Loading and unloading vehicles (max. distance: 10 m from the accommodation or business entrance (e.g. hotel or restaurant entrance/ exit)
- Arrival and departure from accommodation
- Individuals with special authorisation from the community of Ischgl



NOISE

It is not permitted to make disruptive noise (e.g. loud shouting) or to breach the public peace. Please act with consideration towards other guests who wish to enjoy their holiday in Ischgl in peace!
