

With these COVID rules you'll spend your holidays in Paznaun safely.

As of September 15, a staged plan will apply, based on the utilization of ICU capacity (for details, see page 3). This info sheet is continuously adapted to the current legal situation.

In all accommodations, culinary establishments, leisure and sports facilities and at events, the following applies for those aged 12 and over:

Entry only with the 3G-rules: Vaccinated - tested - recovered

Vaccinated:

- Proof by means of immunisation passport, immunisation card or print-out
- From the **second vaccination** (must not be more than **360 days** ago)
- As of the **22nd day** after vaccination with vaccine requiring **only one jab** (must not be more than **270 days** ago)
- Vaccination valid **immediately** if a positive COVID-test was completed at least **21 days** before vaccination, or a **positive antibody test** immediately before vaccination (The vaccination must not be more than **360 days** ago)

Tested:

- Negative **PCR-Test** (validity: **72 hours**)*
- Negative **antigen test** from physician, pharmacy, etc. (validity: **24 hours**)*
- Negative **antigen test** from test centre (nearest test centre in Zams; validity: **24 hours**)
- Negative **antigen test** for **self-administration** (self-test), recorded in an official data processing system (validity: **24 hours**)

*Not free for foreign guests

Recovered:

- Up to **6 months** after end of the infection (proof: isolation certificate, medical confirmation)
- Positive **antibody test**, no older than 3 months



Mask everywhere where it's necessary

- **FFP2 masks** required for everyone on public transport, in cable cars, and essential businesses such as supermarkets, chemists, petrol stations, banks
- **FFP2 masks** required for unvaccinated individuals in non essential businesses such as clothing stores. However, wearing an FFP2 mask is also recommended for vaccinated individuals.



Avoid shaking hands



Wash or disinfect your hands several times daily



Sneeze or cough into your elbow or handkerchief

These rules apply in the individual areas:

Catering



- 3G-Rule (Vaccinated - Tested - Recovered)
- Registration compulsory for stays longer than 15 minutes
- Admission to **night gastronomy** only for **vaccinated** people and people with a current **negative PCR test** result

Accommodation



- 3G-Rule (Vaccinated - Tested - Recovered)

Shops



- **FFP2 masks** required for everyone on essential businesses such as supermarkets, chemists, petrol stations, banks
- **FFP2 masks** required for unvaccinated individuals in non essential businesses such as clothing stores. However, wearing an FFP2 mask is also recommended for vaccinated individuals.

Leisure facilities



- 3G-Rule (Vaccinated - Tested - Recovered)

Body-hugging services



(Hairdressers etc.)

- 3G-Rule (Vaccinated - Tested - Recovered)

Public transport

(Bus, cable car, taxi)

- FFP2 mask



Events



25 people or more:

- 3G-Rule (Vaccinated - Tested - Recovered)

100 people or more:

- Registration compulsory
- Registrable

500 people or more:

- Subject to additional permit with the authorities

Health



If you suspect you have a COVID-19 infection:

- Please remain in your accommodation
- Call Hotline 1450 or the doctor in the respective district

Museums



- 3G-proof and registration required for guided tours and events
- **FFP2 masks** required for unvaccinated individuals (and those who have not recovered during the past six months) when the 3G rule does not apply

Departure



- Before departure, please check the statutory travel conditions in the country you are travelling to.

staged plan for autumn:

Depending on the situation in Austria's intensive care units, stricter rules may be imposed during the autumn.

Stage 1:

10%
utilization



(200 occupied intensive care beds Austria-wide)

As of September 15:

- Antigen tests only valid for 24 h as entry tests for restaurants, hotels etc.
- FFP2 masks (instead of regular face masks) required for everyone on public transport, in cable cars, and essential businesses such as supermarkets, chemists, petrol stations, banks
- FFP2 masks required in all shops and museums for those that are not vaccinated or have recovered from COVID
- Proof of vaccination, past infection, or negative test required for events and gatherings of 25 people and more

Stage 2:

15%
utilization



7 days after exceeding:

- Night-time catering and Large events without assigned seating: Admission only for vaccinated or recovered persons
- antigen test for self-administration (self-test) are no longer valid as evidence

Stage 3:

20%
utilization



7 days after exceeding:

- everywhere where the 3G rule applies: access only for vaccinated, recovered or with negative PCR test
